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Set up a QSEHRA and help your pastor

Are you a small church or organization with a handful of employees but you want to support their health and wellbeing? You can contribute to their healthcare costs through a Qualified Small Employer Health Reimbursement Arrangement. A QSEHRA allows employers with fewer than 50 employees to provide non-taxed reimbursement of certain healthcare expenses, like health insurance premiums and coinsurance. 
