

## **Determining Eligibility**

Church Workers' Assistance Plan is a grant program honoring the Church of the Brethren's commitment to mutuality within the church.

- Grants are available to active and retired employees of Church of the Brethren congregations, districts, and camps, and their surviving spouses.\*
- To be eligible, active and retired employees must have worked at least half-time.\*\*

## Types of Assistance

Need-based assistance grants will depend on need and years of service. Types of grants available for active and retired pastors and church employees include:

- Monthly support
- Debt reduction
- Final expenses
- Emergency
- Medicare supplement premium

\*Each grant has its own requirement regarding active vs. retired and also clergy vs. non-clergy. Grants are taxable to the recipient, except for coaching provided through the Flourishing in Ministry program.

\*\*There may be exceptions granted to clergy members who serve a congregation without compensation.

## Wellness Coaching & Support

Well-being assistance is not based on financial need. These programs were created to help individuals flourish, they focus on mental and financial well-being.

- Resilience coaching through the Flourishing in Ministry program is available to all active clergy and their spouses.
- Well-being grants for counseling are also available to active clergy and all members of their immediate household.
- Financial wellness grants are available to all active and retired employees of churches, districts, and camps.
